Proposed DASH or Bus Route Through Glassell Park

At its meeting of January 28, 2016, the Economic Development and Land Use Committee received a presentation and exhibits from Committee member Andrew Montealegre outlining a proposal to return and expand a bus route through Glassell Park. Line 176 was formerly routed through Glassell Park but was terminated several years ago. It ran along Ave 50, El Paso, and Division Streets to San Fernando Rd.

The proposal would incorporate that segment but extend it from the Gold Line Station in Highland Park to the Red Line Station at Sunset and Vermont. From the Highland Park station it would travel down Figueroa to Ave 50, northerly along Ave 50 to El Paso until it meets Division St, then follow Division to San Fernando Rd. It would take San Fernando Rd to Fletcher and follow Fletcher to Rowena then turn west on Hyperion. As Hyperion merges onto Sunset it would follow Sunset to the Red Line Station at Vermont.

The proposed route traverses many activity centers and schools and provides service to a portion of Rowena where there is none. It provides connector service to rail lines for Highland Park, Glassell Park, Cypress Park, Atwater, Silver Lake and Los Feliz.

The bus service could either be a DASH line or a regular bus but it was noted that a DASH bus would minimize any disturbances to streets and neighborhoods. It should be noted that LA's Department of Transportation is in the midst of conducting a survey that is looking for suggested transportation routes.

Committee members voted unanimously to recommend to the Council that the project be supported and that the Board forward their recommendations to other neighborhood councils impacted by the proposal.
