At its meeting of November 14, 2014, the Economic Development and Land Use Committee reviewed plans presented by the representative, Kiyoshi Graves, of an existing warehouse/office building proposed for a change of use to artist studios (no residential). The application is to request 70 on-site parking spaces (32 standard, 23 compact, 3 ADA, 1 ADA van, 11 via provision of 44 on-site bicycle spaces as per code), in lieu of the required 94 spaces.

In its discussion of the application members took into account the following points:

- --according to the applicant the building has been functioning as artists studios for several years
- --committee members have not noticed an impact on San Fernando Rd parking despite its proximity to Super King
- -- there is often parking on San Fernando Road's parallel side road adjacent to the project
- --the project and its parking requirements do not include a residential component
- --the artist's studios do not have sleeping quarters and the building will not be permitted for artist's residences
- --some members wanted the façade to be "brightened up" and the applicant was asked what they could provide
- -- the property owner stated have been looking at ways to do this

A motion was proposed and seconded to support approval of the application with the addition of a condition that the applicant make a "good faith effort" to bring color and landscape to the San Fernando Road façade.

Motion was adopted to support the application with the condition as stated above.

Vote: 4 in favor, 0 opposed. Motion carried.
