Re: Wireless internet service in GP Community & Senior Center

Dear Mr. Rodriguez and Mr. Ilomin:

The Glassell Park Neighborhood Council hereby requests that Council District 1 install wireless internet service at your Glassell Park Field Office and that you provide access to that service to all tenants of the building at no cost to them.

Internet access is a crucial tool for your Field Office to properly serve the community. How can your Constituent Services Director function when people come to him for answers and he cannot access the internet?

There are groups who use those offices that do not have the funds (or even the phone lines) to bring in their own service. Allowing those groups to use the Council District's system would cost nothing more and greatly help those groups--GPNC, GPIA, Seniors and the many others who use the facility regularly--to do their work in the community. In addition, as a public service to our community, the City's Dept. of Recreation & Parks teaches computer classes in the building; having wireless internet access would improve the value of those classes immeasurably.

Please let the Glassell Park Neighborhood Council know the status of our request.
