Dear Mayor Garcetti,

With this letter, the Glassell Park Neighborhood Council respectfully requests that you explore transforming the medians along Eagle Rock Boulevard in Glassell Park into outdoor venues for public art.

Glassell Park has an incredible untapped amenity in its medians along Eagle Rock Boulevard. They are wide and expansive and are reminiscent of the creative artistic medians along Santa Monica Boulevard in the City of West Hollywood.

The medians on Santa Monica Boulevard have become an iconic emblem for the creative and artistic spirit of the City of West Hollywood. So we ask, why can't our medians along Eagle Rock Boulevard do the same for our community?

Art on the Outside is a program of the West Hollywood Fine Arts Commission to install temporary exhibits of engaging and exploratory contemporary art in public spaces throughout the city. The program works with artists who wish to explore outdoor space and/or who wish to bring their art out of the traditional and at times limiting confines of galleries into the public realm.

The Glassell Park Neighborhood Council requests that a similar program be instituted in the City of Los Angeles and that an Art on the Outside Subcommittee be established to specifically look at creating art medians in Glassell Park. This program and subcommittee can be a pilot program for the rest of the City and will be a collaborative effort between different Council Districts and various stakeholder groups.

The Glassell Park Neighborhood Council Public Arts Committee is ready to volunteer in any capacity to move this item forward and help with the establishment of the program and subcommittee.
